CAN I USE MY POST 9/11 GI BILL BENEFITS TO ATTEND TRUCK DRIVING SCHOOL?

Yes. Our VA Certifying Officials are ready to help you get started. If you qualify for 90-100% of your benefits, it will cover the full cost of your education.

IF I HAVE A DISABILITY RATING WITH THE VA, CAN I GET FUNDING?

Yes. Sometimes veterans have exhausted their Post 9/11 GI Bill or did not qualify for it, but if you have a disability rating, there is a grant available to cover the full cost of training. There is no housing allowance for this program.

DO I REALLY GET A HOUSING ALLOWANCE WHILE ATTENDING SCHOOL?

Yes. A monthly housing allowance (MHA) is a benefit paid via direct deposit to students while attending school under the Post-9/11 GI Bill, and is equal to the Basic Allowance for Housing (BAH).
